- **Non-Agriculture Component** - ICT, Construction Materials, Tourism, Transport & Logistics, Apparel, Packaging, BSPs;
- **Agriculture Component** - Fruit, Vegetables, Wine, Nuts;
- **Business Enabling Environment Component** – Property Rights, Regulatory Environment & Licensing, Investment Promotion, Trade & Customs, Tax, Procurement & Privatization, Agricultural Policy;
- **Crosscutting** – University Partnerships, PPPs, Access to Finance, E-Governance, Information and Knowledge Sharing;

E-Governance Projects - Government to Business Solutions:

- **E-Filing System** - Online trademark and patent registration, faster processing time, standard form of application, electronic data trail;
- **State Property Management System** - Database of state property; greater publicity and transparency of privatization process;
- **Electronic ID** – Reliable identification, electronic authentication, electronic voting, digital signatures;

- **Agriculture Commodity Price Database** – Online access to product prices, locations, timing, logistics and transportation services;
- **Trade Net** – Concept of interfacing organizations onto one Electronic Platform, Single Window, access to various service providers.
- **IT Innovation Center** – IT shared services center, R&D, university curriculum development, educational & international certification programs, networking, BSP services, business incubation, improved use of IT among SMEs.
